



**Kidsgrove Park  
247 West Sassafras  
Street**

Kidsgrove is a 3.25 acre neighborhood park maintained and operated by Kidsgrove, Inc. The park contains a large wooden play structure, universal swings and sandbox, a band shell, picnic pavilions and tables, accessible walking path and permanent restrooms that are open seasonally. **Anthony Selin Woods  
520 South High  
Street**

This facility is across the street from High Street Manor on South High Street. This is also the location of the LifeTrail which includes ten fitness stations. Also provided is a picnic pavilion and tables for residents use.



**Major Anthony  
Selin Park

Street**

The park contains a playground for children age 2-5, horseshoe, quoits and basketball courts, volleyball court, tree museum, picnic pavilion, restrooms and off-street parking. It adjoins Anthony Selin Woods, Kidsgrove Park and the AYSO soccer fields. The pavilion contains kitchen facilities and is available for rental. A supervised playground program is offered mornings for ten weeks during the summer. During the summer of 2011, this program will offer a sport-camp atmosphere promoting physical activity. Activities will include soccer, baseball, lacrosse, volleyball, basketball, etc. A different sport will be featured each week. The program consists of fitness and sports activities.

**Pump House Park and Gazebo  
116 & 119 East Snyder Street**

The Pump House Park includes a building that can be rented for any meeting, party, or group event. This facility contains restrooms and a kitchen, as well as a meeting space that comfortably seats about 30 people and can be rearranged for as many as 60. The Gazebo is another great feature of the park, located in an attractive setting along Penns Creek. The Gazebo is a popular spot for outdoor weddings, and also hosts a concert series of local performers during June, July and August. For reservations, call the Borough Office.

**Pump House Mini-Playground  
119 North Water Street**

Across the alley from the Pump House Park is a small fenced-in play area, full of brightly-colored playground equipment. Swings, slides and other features make this playground a fun place for kids.



**Little Norway II  
101 East Sassafras  
Street**

Open during Winter months. This man-made pond is flooded with water each winter season to provide an enjoyable skating area in town. The rink is completely maintained by volunteers in the community and provides outdoor fun during the winter months. There is a building next to the skating rink that was recently renovated to include concessions and a cozy fireplace. Skating and ice skates are free of charge.

Open during Summer months. The Selinsgrove Pool is a popular summer spot to relax and cool off. Built on top of a hill, the pool overlooks the Borough of Selinsgrove and the Susquehanna River Valley. The pool complex is located within a residential area, and conveniently right next to the Selinsgrove Elementary and High Schools. The pool features a main swimming area, a diving stand, zero-depth entry, enclosed tube slide, T-cross bar, rain drop, toddler pool, a bathhouse, and pavilion area. There is also a concession stand, grassy hillside, and hand-painted scenes covering the building walls. The complex is completely fenced in, and is a great location for people of all ages during the summer months. Private parties and pool rentals are available by calling 374-3548.

**Isle of Que Boat  
Launch & River Access  
700 South Front Street**



This area on the Isle of Que includes a boat ramp for easy access in and out of the Susquehanna River, a paved parking lot, picnic tables and an attractive area to sit along the river bank. The boat ramp provides a great service to all those who love and use the river. Selinsgrove Projects Inc. supports a River Paddle during July. River tours are available to those interested.

**Rotary Field and  
Pavilion  
508 Tenth Street**



This space, developed by the Selinsgrove Rotary Club, contains a picnic pavilion, as well as a Little League baseball field, concession stand and restrooms. When the weather is nice, kids can often be spotted playing sports in the grassy field next to the pavilion. In the fall, you will see the Midget Football League practicing football.



**Moose Playground  
15 West Mill Street**

This large playground includes an area with a variety of play equipment, as well as a shaded pavilion. There is also a basketball court for kids of all ages. Located in the middle of town, this playground is convenient and full of fun activities.



**Dog Park  
243 West Sassafras  
Street**

This facility was established in 2010 for our four-legged friends. Volunteers worked throughout the spring and summer to install fencing and create the dog park area. Watch for continued improvements.

**Veterans Memorial  
Penns Creek Access  
231 South Water Street**



This facility was established in 2010 as a public access to Penns Creek to launch or remove kayaks and canoes or to just enjoy sitting along the bank. It is located adjacent to the Ice Skating Rink. Picnic facilities including tables are available. Volunteers created this area in remembrance of those citizens who have served our country.

**AYSO Soccer Fields

The American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), in cooperation with Selinsgrove Borough and Susquehanna University, operates and maintains the soccer fields. It is primarily used by AYSO for soccer league play and lacrosse.
